

**SYD WRIGHT ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM AWARD
DRAMA/DEBATE/FORENSICS**

Syd Wright was an Alaskan educator for over 30 years. He served as a superintendent, principal, teacher and coach, and was recognized as teacher and principal of the year. As an administrator he encouraged unorthodox teaching methods even though he sometimes had to publicly defend this approach. As a teacher Wright recognized the untapped potential in every student. He demanded excellence and his students eagerly went beyond his expectations. He was truly an inspiration to all.

Region V presents an academic award to the school with the DDF team that has the highest team GPA. To be considered for the academic award a school must have a minimum of three members.

COMPUTING TEAM GPA

- Compute a cumulative GPA for all team members.
- Count every course that a student has listed on their report card except those that are pass/fail.
- Student GPA: For each course listed multiply the point value of the grade by the number of semester credits received for the course. A 4.0 GPA grade system must be used. (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0) Disregard pluses and minuses.
- Team GPA: Compute team average by adding all team member GPAs and then dividing by the number of team members.
