- Deadline for Commitment to State and Regions is September 25, 2020 - Must notify the Region intent to participate at the Region Meet & State. If you are not attending state, you do not show up at Regions to mitigate unnecessary participation.
- Top 7 Boys and Top 7 Girls ONLY at Regions Max.

Division II:

Teams: Sitka, Mt. Edgecumbe

Race Time: Saturday Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> 10am @ Totem Park

Division 2: Top 4 boys/ Top 4 Girls will qualify regardless of community/school they represent

AWARDS:

**Top 12 Runners** - In both Boys and Girls Race will receive a medal

**Top 6 State Qualifiers** - In both Boys and Girls Race will receive a medal

**CATEGORY #1**

**OPTION #1**

Regionals @ Petersburg October 2- 3, 2020.

- Plan to have teams run with their boys and girls' team on the same course, but with separate time slots.

EXAMPLE:

- Friday Petersburg @ 2:00pm
- Friday Wrangell @ 3:15pm

- Saturday Craig/Klawock @ 11:00am
- Saturday Haines @ 12:30pm
  - Must be in attendance to qualify within the top 14
  - TOP 14 Runners will qualify regardless of community/school they represent
  - Deadline for Commitment to State and Regions is September 25, 2020. Must notify the Region intent to participate at the Region Meet & State.
  - Top 7 Boys and Top 7 Girls ONLY at Regions Meet.
  - If any team plans on NOT competing at State or the Region meet in person...they have the option of virtually competing on the course that was run on September 12th, 2020 and be included in the Region results. BUT, will be pulled out of determining the top 14 that qualify for the state event.

### **OPTION #2**

**(In the case Option #1 is not approved by Petersburg's Incident Command Center & or increase in Active Cases).**

Regionals Virtual - top 14 times. \*\*We could do the course that we did for the first Virtual since we have a virtual timeline on this course already and have an idea of what people's times are

- Course #1 That you did virtually.
  - Top 14 Times for both boys and girls
  - Intent to participate due September 25, 2020.

#### **OPTION #2**

With the Region 5 Division III Meet in Petersburg, the Region will award the following for participants that show up in person to the Region Event.

Top 14 Runners - In both Boys and Girls Race will receive a medal. Top 14 receive medals.

First Place Team Trophy - in both boys and girls' race (Virtual teams NOT included in this category)

Second Place Team Trophy - in both boys and girls' race (Virtual teams NOT included in this category)

Top 14 runners in both boys and girls qualify for state.
